

# ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSION

## The Prabowo Presidency in Indonesia: Prospects for Democracy, the Political Economy & Geopolitics

Prabowo Subianto was elected as Indonesia's eighth president in early 2024. His election marks a new phase in Indonesian politics. The 2014 and 2019 elections had been characterized by sharp polarization between Prabowo and his rival, Joko Widodo, which also impacted grassroots relations between various communities. After the 2019 contest, however, Widodo invited his defeated rival Prabowo into his government, and later made him his heir. Since then, polarization has made way to the notion of all-inclusive government that leaves little room for opposition. This roundtable discussion, which brings some of the world's leading Indonesian politics experts from the Australian National University (ANU) to Japan, will assess what Prabowo's presidency is likely to look like in the arenas of politics, political economy and international relations.

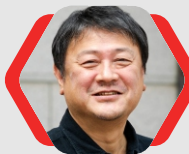
